The Lok Sabha simulation offers delegates the opportunity to step into the shoes of India's elected representatives and engage in structured parliamentary debate. Delegates navigate legislative challenges, policy reforms, political negotiations, and party dynamics while upholding parliamentary procedure.

Agenda: Reforming India's Criminal Justice System: Strengthening Forensic Capacity, Reducing Judicial Delays, and Enhancing Police Modernisation.

AIPPM brings together representatives of major national and regional parties to deliberate on key political issues shaping India's future. Delegates engage in consensus building, strategic negotiation, party stance articulation, and coalition politics.

Agenda: Evaluating India's National Cybersecurity Preparedness and Political Strategies to Counter Emerging Threats.



The GLA simulation provides delegates with a realistic experience of state-level policymaking and governance. Participants debate region-specific challenges, development issues, administrative reforms, and state legislation.

Agenda: Reviewing Gujarat's Urban Flood Management Strategy and Climate Adaptation Measures.

UNGA

The UNGA is a global platform where member nations discuss international peace, humanitarian crises, and multilateral cooperation. Delegates represent nations, negotiate resolutions, and collaborate on balanced solutions to world issues.

Agenda: Addressing global instability arising from the strategic competition over critical minerals, with special emphasis on resource rich & politically vulnerable regions.

The UNHRC focuses on promoting and protecting human rights across all regions. Delegates debate humanitarian crises, discrimination, civil liberties, and international human rights frameworks.

Agenda: Examining the use of sectarian policies as mechanisms of state authority, with special focus on human rights abuses stemming from religious discrimination and the protection of displaced minorities

The UNSC provides delegates with a high-intensity diplomatic experience involving crisis management, cross-border tensions, national security, and international peace.

Agenda: Addressing the escalation of Armed Conflicts and Threats to International peace and security resulting from Iran - Israel region crisis
